Atencio's promo on Dana would have been a lot more impressive if he had really won a fight.

Good, smart performance by Horodecki. Didn't strike with a striker even though he's a striker himself, and took the guy into uncomfortable areas and subbed him.

Too bad about Din Thomas but again it points to the the incompetence of the promotion and commission. He's overweight, you tell him he's not, let him start rehydrating, then tell him he has to make the weight? Amateur Night in Dixie. Vasquez vs. Thomas would be a real good fight. Vasquez is an ace and has a star vibe and the poor local yokel who stepped in to take the fight didn't have a chance in hell and fortunately Vasquez finished him quick and clean.

McKee vs. Thompson was looking like the first actual technical contest of the card before the bizarre finish. Wish they had replayed the moment when whatever happened happened. Thompson certainly wasn't tapping from those pittypat strikes. In any case, the one good fight got ruined.
